At the beginning of the Council Transition meeting, Full Council will first be choosing an elder for the responsibility of Chair of Council.

DEACONS

After the above is done, the Deacons then leave and meet separately. In their meeting, the Deacons will be choosing a Chair, a Vice-Chair, a Secretary, and the other distinct responsibilities that individual deacons may have.

ELDERS

In their meeting, the elders will decide which roles each individual elder will assume, either pastoral or executive. Incumbent elders get the first choice, and it is encouraged that an elder continue in the role (either pastoral or executive) that they start their term in. New elders are then asked where they think they can best serve and where this is possible, this is accommodated.

When this is done, Pastoral Council will meet separately. Pastoral Council will be choosing their Chair and Vice-Chair. Pastoral Council will also discuss and assign the various districts.

Council Executive will meet separately to discuss and assign the various roles for the members of Council Executive as per the Organization Chart (attached), including the role of Stated Clerk.
