

Worship Team Ministry

VISION/GOAL:

The goal of the Worship Team Music Ministry is to accompany, facilitate, and enhance the singing of the people of God during worship at church, in order to engage the hearts and minds of the congregation to worship God.

The Worship Team provides musical leadership as we praise God together in song during worship using a blended worship style incorporating both traditional as well as contemporary music.

RESPONSIBILITY OF WORSHIP TEAM LEADER:

- Organize the Worship Team (comprised of 3 – 10 musicians)
- Coordinate with Worship Planner to plan music and song selections for worship services.
- Organize rehearsals.
- Distribute music in advance of rehearsals.
- Represent the Worship Team at Worship Committee and Worship Planners meetings.
- Following up with team and members of the church for ways to improve.
- Developing new musicians and teams as people are interested in worship leading.

REQUIREMENTS AND SKILLS OF TEAM MEMBERS:

- Be a follower of Jesus Christ.
- Generally, Worship Team members are members of GCRC, however, occasionally, there may be guest musicians, at the discretion of the Worship Team Leader.
- Have musical gifts and abilities and a level of skill that will make a valuable contribution.
- Be prepared to commit regularly to midweek rehearsals and Sunday services.
- Be open to taking direction from the Worship Team Leader.
- Maintain a servant attitude by placing greater importance on serving others than playing music, and being noticed.

RESPONSIBILITY OF WORSHIP TEAM MEMBERS:

- To grow and develop their musical talents through supervision, mentoring, and practice in order to effectively lead the congregation.
- Giving their best in worship and take responsibility to be a good example
- Being willing to submit to leadership and respond positively to constructive criticism.
- Practicing songs in advance and being prepared and on time for rehearsals and worship services.
- To encourage and include newcomers, including children and youth who are developing their musical gifts.
