TRANSPORTATION POLICY

FOR GEORGETOWN CHRISTIAN REFORMED CHURCH RELATED ACTIVITIES

- 1. At least two of the following procedures must be in place:
 - Two adults are present and seated in the front seat of the vehicle when transporting youth
 - At least two youth are present in the vehicle
 - Youth are seated in the back seat of the vehicle
 - Drivers log-in each pick up and drop off: logs are turned into program supervisor
- 2. Adults must have a valid driver's license and proof of insurance before transporting youth.
- 3. Drivers need to abide by the provincial requirements for car seat, seatbelt use and airbag safety.
 - Youth are to wear seatbelts whenever the vehicle is in service. Drivers may not transport more youth than available seatbelts.
 - When required by law, car seats must be available for younger children.
 - For safety, youth under the age of 10 may not sit in the front seat if there is a passenger-side airbag.
