VISION:

Our role is to make sure that the sound is optimized during the worship service to assist the congregation in joining the worship experience.

To use the sound equipment to allow the congregation to hear the worship team, speakers and other media used in the Sunday morning services and other events (i.e. weddings, funerals, etc.) where sound is required.

SKILLS USED BY VOLUNTEERS:

- Able to work well with the pastor, guest speakers, worship leader / team / planners and other participants
- Consistently prepared and on time for the responsibility of Sound
- Demonstrates expertise and professionalism in the technical arts (training can be provided) and possess creative skills
- An ear to be able to adjust the levels for when the worship team, pastor or speaker is on
- Understanding of flow and basic sound reinforcement setup
- Ability to set-up, run and troubleshoot the sound system
- The ability to accept criticism and willingness to be trained

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Turn on and run sound equipment, including mixer, microphones, monitors, audio players, etc.
- Set up microphones, when required
- Before and during worship services, attentively listen and adjust levels of individual microphones and equipment, when required
- Work with the Livestream team to ensure that the sound on the recording is as good as in the Church building.
- Willing and able to be on sound at least once a month
- Finding a substitute when you can not cover you scheduled turn
