Bill of Rights for Christ's Servants

1. When you are asked to serve as a volunteer in our church's ministry, you are entitled to know details of the work involved, the time commitment you are being asked to make and the term of your commitment. We appreciate your commitment.
2. You may expect that you will be provided with the resources you need in order to be effective in your ministry. This includes both basic "tools" (physical supplies) and, as needed, on – going training and up – dating (by way of seminars or conferences).
3. Since you are the one who has been asked to carry out ministry, you are encouraged to express your views on how that ministry might be improved or enhanced. We want to hear from you.
4. You may expect that you will be encouraged in the volunteer work you have committed yourself to do. If you become discouraged because you do not receive tokens of appreciation or because your work is belittled, that will also affect your ministry. We need to hear from you.
5. You are asked to serve in a ministry of our Church, but that ministry is carried out as part of our relationship with Jesus Christ and you will be encouraged to grow in your relationship with Him.
6. You are encouraged, in the course of your ministry, to form and enhance relationships with other members of our Church community and this will also ensure your own healthy involvement in ministry.

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
